*Raising Funds and Awareness for Breast Cancer Research
Save the date – Mother's Day, May 9*

On Sunday, May 9, hundreds of youth and adults will run to help raise awareness for breast cancer patients and their loved ones. They will be participating in "The Race," a charity event started by **Josh Berns**, 17, and his sister **Dani Berns**, 15, who wanted to make a difference and support friends and family members who were battling breast cancer. After organizing The Race, Josh's own mother, **Patti Berns**, was diagnosed with breast cancer.

Families and children can participate in The Race while raising money for research for an important cause. Refreshments, entertainment, prizes and children's activities will be part of the day's festivities. Prizes will be awarded to the individual who raises the most money as well as to the school/team with the greatest participation.

The Race, now in its seventh year, is a one-mile walk/run at Legacy Village. Registration opens at 8 a.m. and the race kicks off at 9 a.m.
